The Tribe is salvaging the fire damaged timber and is replanting more than a million seedlings to restore their lands for future wildfire resilience.

PURPOSE Known for its natural rot resistance, Incense Cedar is ideal for exterior applications such as siding, fencing, decking, trim, fascia and soffits and makes a beautiful, aromatic wall & ceiling paneling for interiors. This softwood has a fine grain and is easy to work with. It is the most fire and drought resistant conifer species, which may serve us well as our climate changes.

PEOPLE The Cow Creek Umpqua people have a deep connection with the land, the water, and the natural world around them. They are stewarding their forests in a holistic way, for the benefit of their Tribal members, their surrounding communities, and the future generations. We are honored to support their work.
