In 2019, more than 3600 acres of newly reacquired forestland was devastated in a wildfire. The Tribe has salvaged the fire damaged timber and is replanting more than a million seedlings to restore their lands for future wildfire resilience.

PURPOSE Known for its strength and structural integrity, Douglas Fir is also used for flooring, trim & siding, wall paneling and butcher block countertops. This softwood is beautiful, easy to work with, and is an incredibly important Northwest resource, both economically and environmentally.

PEOPLE The Cow Creek Umpqua people have a deep connection with the land, the water, and the natural world around them. They are stewarding their forests in a holistic way, for the benefit of their Tribal members, their surrounding communities, and the future generations. We are honored to support their work.
