

NORTHWEST LIVE-EDGE SLABS

Our live-edge slabs feature the variegated natural edge of the tree, with all its unique characteristics. The tree's life story is visible before your eyes: Its size, bark, sapwood, heartwood, knots and burls, color variations, even the mineral streaking that adds personality to each piece and describes the soil conditions in which the tree was grown.

PEOPLE & PLANET

These slabs are sourced from small mills throughout the Pacific Northwest. Ask us where yours came from -- we can share the story behind each piece.

All slabs are kiln-dried for stability. Most are 2" thick, but other thicknesses are available for custom projects. Due to the unique nature of each piece, widths, lengths, and character vary.

- » Campground Blue Pine Sourced from salvage projects on public lands in western Montana
- FSC Big Leaf Maple (FSC C041262) Harvested from well-managed, FSC certified forests west of the Cascade Range
- » Pacific Madrone Salvaged from the waste stream in the Rogue and Umpqua Valleys
- » Willamette Valley Walnut Sourced from orchard salvage projects in the Willamette Valley
- » Restoration Juniper Sourced from rangeland restoration projects in central and eastern Oregon
- » Deodar Cedar Sourced from urban salvage projects in the Portland metro area
