# ROCKY MOUNTAIN INSTITUTE

## SCOPE OF PROJECT

For their new headquarters, Rocky Mountain Institute partnered with Portland-based ZGF Architects to create an energy-efficient building that meets the criteria of the Living Building Challenge. The new building was completed in 2016.

Our Restoration Juniper Siding was selected for the exterior surfaces of the building. This selection meets the requirements of the Living Building Challenge and contributes a unique, natural look, decades of durability, and a compelling story.

## PEOPLE & PLANET

Juniper is a native species that has become invasive due to decades of human interference on the landscape. Today, collaborative groups including ranchers, government agencies, environmental organizations, and a network of lumber mills in rural communities are working together to restore the landscape, harvesting the wood and milling it into beautiful, useful lumber products.
