

JUNIPER SIDING

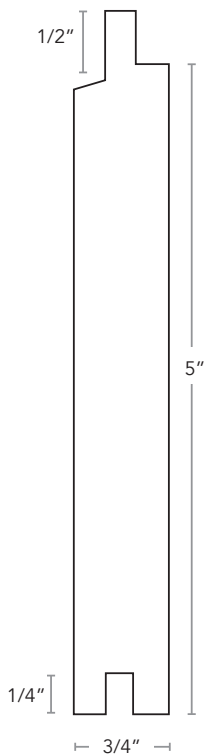
Sustainable Northwest Wood offers a wide variety of exterior siding products for residential and commercial projects. Our Restoration Juniper siding is offered in four common profiles: tongue-and-groove with a bevel (WP-4), rainscreen parallelogram, faux board and batt and tongue-and-groove with a channel. All Juniper options are kiln-dried and precisely milled to ensure that each board interlocks with the board next to it. This further ensures a beautiful, durable and long-lasting siding to protect your structure. Pre-staining and pre-finishing available upon request.

Restoration Juniper comes from rangeland restoration projects in Central and Eastern Oregon. Juniper is a native species, but decades of fire suppression have allowed it to take over what was formerly a grassland ecosystem. As a result, many acres of juniper are now being harvested to restore groundwater supplies and essential habitat for threatened species like the sage grouse.



JUNIPER SIDING SPECIFICATION

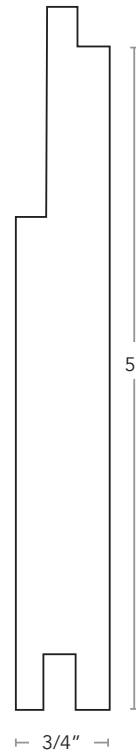
- » Species: Western Juniper (*Juniperus occidentalis*)
- » Grade: #1 Kiln Dried
- » Profiles: Tongue-and-groove with a bevel (WP-4), rainscreen parallelogram, faux board and batt and tongue-and-groove with a channel.
- » Dimensions: 3/4" x 5" x Random length (6-8')
- » Hardness – 665 (Janka)



JUNIPER CHANNEL

A subtle 1/4" reveal provides a contemporary look and accommodates seasonal expansion and contraction of the wood. The channel also has a slight bevel that sheets water away from the home. This tongue-and-groove siding securely locks together and is ideal for a seamless waterproof barrier in a horizontal application.

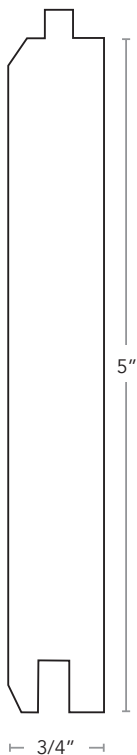
Thickness is 3/4"

FAUX BOARD AND BATT

This siding recreates the classic style of barn siding with a modern twist of contrasting smooth and rough textures. Single piece construction simplifies installation and minimizes material waste. The tongue and groove hold this profile securely in place in a typical vertical application.

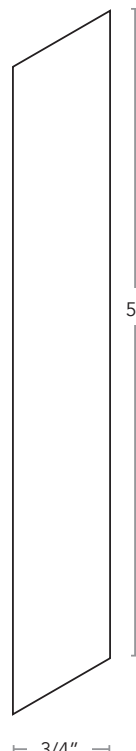
Thickness is 3/4"

JUNIPER CLASSIC

Our 5" tongue and groove with a bevel (WP-4) is a classic profile that can be reversed to offer a flush fit face. Typically this profile is used as interior paneling, but left with a textured face it can also perform well as exterior siding.

ROCKY MOUNTAIN RAINSCREEN

Modern building technology loves this old school profile for its ability to allow for air flow yet keep out water. A small gap between the boards keeps moisture from collecting while a 30 degree bevel provides both a visual and rain barrier. Simple installation is another selling point.

Thickness is 3/4"
Lengths: Random 6'-8'
